The APO Award

•The APO Award was first established by APO in 1978 to give recognition to individuals who have made outstanding contribution to the promotion and improvement of productivity in the Asia Pacific Region. It was conferred once every three years until it was revised and expanded in 1985. The revision included renaming the award scheme as the APO Regional Award and the introduction of the category of APO National Award to commend individuals who have made contributions to the cause of productivity in their respective countries. The 2 Awards have been conferred once every five years since 1980.

•The APO Regional & National Awards are open to individuals who have made a significant impact or achievement in one of more of the areas specified below in the Asian-Pacific region and the APO member countries, respectively.

- a. Original thinking, research, or development in devising new concepts and technology for increasing productivity;
- b. Application of techniques in special fields of activity for higher productivity;
- c. Institution building for enhancing productivity; and
- d. Propagation of the concept and techniques for productivity improvement through publications, training activities, or other means.
