Dear Members of the APQO Core council:

1. 15h APQOC Abstracts deadline.

We remind to all core council members that it is their compromise to promote the APQOC so that there will a delegation of a minimum of 5 persons attending the APQOC per country. To ease the registration of papers the deadline to register papers sending a one page abstract was extended for second time until August 15. We encourage to have at least a paper from each of the APQO country members.

2. APQO Attendance.

In order to define the required capacity of the rooms we remind to all APQO country members to send us their estimate of size of his country delegation attending the 15APQOC . We encourage to send that information by August 15.

3. IAPQA Examiners.

The IAPQA is motivating the group of examiners being responsible of the participation fee of two examiners. The Congress is looking also support to waive of registration fee other two examiners.

4.Official Hotel.

We can now announce that the venue hotel will be the Maria Isabel Shertaon Hotel that gives an special rate to participants of only \$100 per night single or double occupancy tax included compared with the normal rate of \$330 US Dlls..
