Seventh National Convention on SQC 2011

7th National Convention on Students' Quality Circles 2011 commenced from October 22nd to 24th at Shuvatara School, Lamatar, Lalitpur, Nepal. The event was organized by Quality Circles in Education for Students Personality Development, Nepal (QUEST-Nepal) in association with Shuvatara School and in cooperation with Government of Nepal, Ministry of Education/ National Centre for Educational Development (NCED), Private and Boarding Schools' Organization Nepal (PABSON), Network for Quality, Productivity and Competitiveness, Nepal (NQPCN), Productivity and Quality Committee/ Federation of Nepalese Chambers of Commerce and Industry (PQC/ FNCCI), Nepal Jesuit Society (NJS), National-Private and Boarding Schools' Association Nepal (N-PABSAN), Nepal English Language Teachers Association (NELTA), Higher Secondary School's Association Nepal (HISSAN), Saraswati Teachers' Training Research & Resource Centre (STRC), Rotary Club of Kathmandu.
